BY-LAW NO.

A By-law to amend Parking By-law No. 6059

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANCOUVER, in public meeting, enacts as follows:

- 1. This By-law amends the indicated provisions of the Parking By-law.
- 2. From section 2, Council repeals the definition of "Sub-area C1".
- 3. From section 3.2.1(e), each time it appears, Council strikes out "or in sub-area C1".
- From the title to section 4.1.3, Council strikes out "or Sub-area C1". 4.
- 5. From section 4.1.3, each time it appears, Council strikes out "or sub-area C1".
- From section 4.3.1, Council strikes out "sections 4.3.2, 4.3.3, 4.3.4, and 4.3.5", and substitutes "section 4.3.2".
- 7. From the titles to sections 4.3.3, 4.3.4, 4.3.5, 4.3.7, and 5.1.2, Council strikes out "and Sub-area C1".
- 8. From sections 4.3.3, 4.3.4, 4.3.5, 4.3.7, and 5.1.2, Council strikes out "and sub-area C1".
- 9. From section 4.3.6, Council strikes out "sections 4.3.7,", and substitutes "sections".
- 10. A decision by a court that any part of this By-law is illegal, void, or unenforceable severs that part from this By-law, and is not to affect the balance of this By-law.
- 11. This By-law is to come into force and take effect on the date of its enactment.
