At the Regular Council meeting on Tuesday, March 2, 2010, Councillor Meggs submitted the following Notice of Motion.

1. Analysis of Streetcar System in the Regional Transportation Network

MOVER: Councillor Geoff Meggs SECONDER: Councillor Andrea Reimer

WHEREAS:

- 1. The City of Vancouver is committed to supporting a major regional investment in public transit as proposed by Translink, cost-shared with senior levels of government, including investments in the Evergreen Line and the critical Broadway UBC corridor, which has extremely high ridership today;
- 2. The Olympic Line streetcar project has been an outstanding success during the Olympics, carrying tens of thousands of people a day between Olympic Village station and Granville Island;
- 3. The Olympic Line pilot program will end in March with the return of the trains to Brussels;
- 4. More analysis is required to determine the potential costs, revenues, ridership and viability of a streetcar network as part of the regional transportation network and in addition whether or not a streetcar line supports the city's priority for regional investment on Broadway;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED

THAT Council direct staff to work with Translink as part of the current UBC Broadway corridor consultation and planning process to ensure a full analysis of the costs and benefits of a streetcar system in the regional transportation network.
