COUNCIL POLICY

The City's Mayor and Council Members' Expenses By-law No 8904 requires that a Council member wishing to engage in an activity that is representing the city, engaging in city business or attending a course, meeting or convention within or outside British Columbia must request Council's prior approval. If Council's approval is granted, the council member may claim reimbursement for expenses incurred in accordance with the By-law.

PURPOSE
