- SUBJECT: CD-1 Text Amendment: 1462 Granville Street (formally 1410 Granville Street)

This memorandum recommends an amendment to the draft By-law to amend CD-1 (579) for 1462 Granville Street (formally 1410 Granville Street), in order to correct a technical error in the permitted building height for the subject site.

## RECOMMENDATION

THAT section 2 of the draft By-law posted for 1462 Granville Street be replaced with the following:

"2. In section 5, Council strikes out "26.2 m" and substitutes "27.31 m" "

## DISCUSSION

The applicant recently confirmed that they inadvertently miscalculated the proposed building height in their application. Instead a building height of 27.05 m as proposed, the correct height should be 27.31 m. This amended building height has no implication on the overall proposed building massing.

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This additional recommendation requires approval by Council to correct the technical error related to the building height in the posted CD-1 By-law.
