Dear Mayor and council,

As a mother of a young family struggling to find stable housing in Vancouver I would like to tell you that I am in favour of densification efforts in Vancouver. However, I find that the densification is only on happening on major roads and this is a concern to me as one of my child is struggling with asthma.

Furthermore, the condo developments have inadequate storage options, in particular, in regards to bicycle storage. For example, I would like to propose that for the re-zoning development at 2106-2138 MAIN STREET, 4621-4663 CAMBIE STREET and 605 WEST 31st AVENUE, to please include a requirement for additional bike and secure storage for the many bicycle users that would like to live in these area. By secure bicycle storage, I mean storage options that would be enclosed, in addition to commuters bike storage. Many people of this city enjoy mountain biking or road biking and commuter bike storage are inadequate. I feel that this request is in line with Vancouver wanting to be a green city and it is very difficult to have these bikes take so much space in small condos.
