

Petition to be presented on the occasion of the Public Hearing for the development at 969 Nelson Street and 1019-1045 Nelson Street on July 25, 2017 (the second day of public comments.)

We the undersigned **oppose** the rezoning application for a 57-storey tower (plus 30' of mechanical space) at 969 Nelson Street and 1019-1045 Nelson Street. We believe this development does serious undue harm to its immediate neighbours on *both* sides of Burrard Street, robbing too many neighbours of the very light and views that make tower dwelling desirable. We believe the city was grossly negligent in its failure to conduct *any* study of the impact of this tower on residents on the east side of Burrard Street. With many more towers planned in the "Burrard Corridor" (between Burrard and Thurlow, from Pacific to Haro), the city must consider case by case the direct impact of these projects on *all* neighbours, including those living on the *other* side of Burrard Street.

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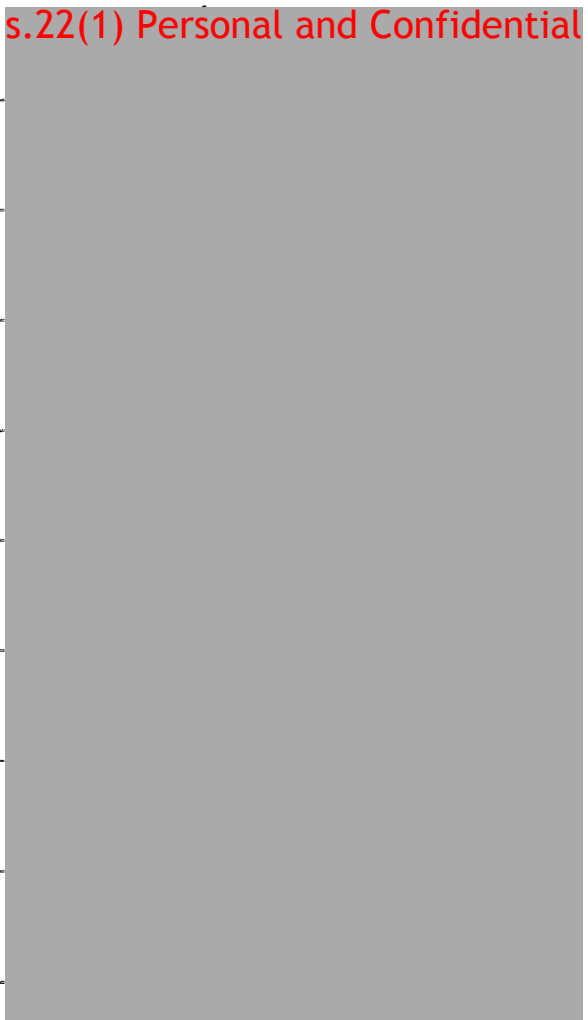

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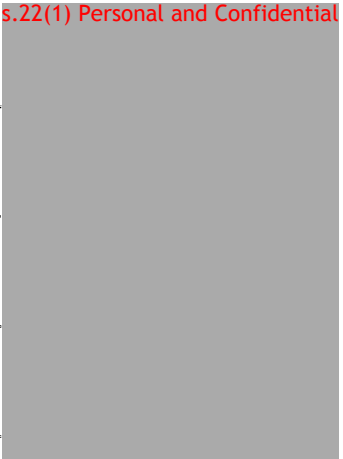
