Background/Context

On Saturday, October 14, 2017, a local by-election was held in the city of Vancouver. There were 442,792 registered voters in the city of Vancouver of which 48,645 voters cast ballots. Voter turnout was 10.99%. As required under the Vancouver Charter, section 108, on

Wednesday, October 18, 2017, as Chief Election Officer, I declared the candidates listed below elected, having received the highest number of votes cast for the respective offices.

At the Regular Council meeting on October 17th, Council asked staff to prepare a review of the 2017 by-election highlighting the approach and activities undertaken in the delivery of the by-election, as well as any lessons that may have been learned. That report will be shared with Council within the next few months.
