



- Existing 10 year contract is expired






Consultation Summary



Consultation Approach

- Notifications, Community Open House in February 2017
- 24 written / digital comments received
- Notification of public hearing

Feedback

- <u>Concerns:</u> brightness, size, distractive effects, impacts to nearby residents and evening workforce
- <u>Support</u>: for increasing community programming, and angling signs towards the street

Analysis and Response

- Signs must meet new Sign Bylaw brightness maximums and have automatic ambient light sensors
- Lowering the signs on the building and angling sign faces toward the street are anticipated to reduce impacts on neighbouring properties
- Driver distraction concerns are not expected due to unique area circumstances

Increased Public Benefits



City Administered Airtime

- Non-profit cultural announcements: 10% of daily regular time
- Video art time available: 5 minutes daily (New)
- Concert time available: 2.5 hours monthly
- Emergency announcements: as needed

Financial Contribution to the City

- \$120,000 annually over the 10 year term (Increased)
- In kind technical assistance (Increased)

LED Sign Technology

- Updated technology and light sensors that are more responsive to ambient light variations
- Aligns with Granville Street Sign District character
