SUBJECT: 2017 Council Remuneration and Expenses

## RECOMMENDATION

THAT Council receive this report for information.

### **REPORT SUMMARY**

Section 196A of the Vancouver Charter requires:

- 1. At least once a year, Council must have prepared a report separately listing for each Council member by name:
  - i. The total amount of remuneration paid to the Council member
  - ii. The total amount of expense payments made under section 196
- 2. The report must be considered by Council at a Council meeting that is open to the public and a copy of the report must be made available for public inspection at City Hall during its regular office hours from the date when it is considered by Council until one year after that date.

## COUNCIL AUTHORITY/PREVIOUS DECISIONS

Council has enacted Bylaws 11483, 11620 and 11529 under Section 196 of the Vancouver Charter to provide remuneration to members of Council and reimbursement of expenditures made or expenses incurred while representing the City, engaging in City business or attending related meetings. ### REPORT

In April 2016 Council enacted Bylaws 11483 *"Mayor and Council Remuneration Bylaw"* and 11620 (minor amendment to 11483). The new bylaws replaced Bylaw 7465 and provide for updated base salaries for Deputy Mayor, Acting Mayor and Councillors. As well, they provide for annual adjustments to Mayor and Councillors' salaries based on the change in the Consumer Price Index for Vancouver (all items) for the 12 months ending October the previous year.

Bylaw 11529 "*Mayor and Council Expense Bylaw*" was enacted in June 2016 to replace Bylaw 8904. The bylaw established an annual discretionary fund for each Councillor to cover eligible expenses incurred while carrying out constituency activities. The new bylaw included housekeeping amendments to provide clarifications for various eligible expenses including the Mayor's discretionary fund which includes the salaries of the Mayor and his staff, travel and transportation, meeting, office and consultant expenses. (For comparative purposes the Mayor's discretionary expenses in the table below are segregated into the same categories as the Councillor expenses).

(1) Remuneration for Councillors include

- Acting Mayor duties for Councillor Louie

- Deputy Mayor duties for Councillor Meggs and Stevenson

- Duty Councilor Fees for Councillor(s) Affleck, Ball, Carr, Deal, De Genova, Jang, Reimer and Stevenson

- Length of Service payment for Councillor Meggs (Resigned in July 2017)

(2) Local expenses include:

- For Mayor, a transportation allowance of \$7,175

- For Councillors - maximum of 10% of remuneration (includes option for taking 60% of the local expense limit as transportation allowance)

- (3) Travel and Conferences net of recoveries (Details in Appendix A). Mayor's expenses include travel and Conferences for political staff
- (4) Discretionary Expenses for Councillors maximum of \$6,000 (Budget is prorated for Meggs, G. and Bremner, H.)
- (5) Mayor's discretionary expenses as per bylaw 11529 expenses are segregated by type
- (6) Elected in October 2017
