SUBJECT: Vancouver Civic Theatres Rental Rates 2019-2020

RECOMMENDATION

A. THAT Council approve the recommended rental rates and fee increases for commercial licensees, as outlined in the Schedule of Rental Rates for Vancouver Civic Theatres (VCT) (Appendix "A), effective September 1, 2019.

B. THAT Council approve the recommended rental rates and fee increases for Notfor-Profit (NFP), Theatre Rental Grant (TRG) and VCT Grant licensees, as outlined in the Schedule of Rental Rates for VCT (Appendix "B"), effective September 1, 2019.

REPORT SUMMARY

This report seeks approval of the recommended fee increases of 4% for commercial licensees, as outlined in the Schedule of Rental Rates contained in Appendix "A", for rental use of VCT during the period of September 1, 2019 to August 31, 2020.

This report seeks approval of recommended fee increases of 2% for NFP, TRG, and VCT Grant licensees, as outlined in the Schedule of Rental Rates contained in Appendix "B", for rental use of VCT during the period of September 1, 2019 to August 31, 2020.

COUNCIL AUTHORITY/PREVIOUS DECISIONS

Council approves the Schedule of Rental Rates for VCT on an annual basis as recommended by staff.




General Manager of Arts. Culture, and Community Services recommends approval of the new fee schedule.

REPORT

Background/Context

Rental rates are reviewed each year prior to the preparation of the annual operating budget. Adjustments are made effective September 1st of each year in alignment with the traditional performing arts season. The rental rates are reviewed primarily in relation to operational cost increases, and are reviewed in relation to those of comparable facilities to ensure that VCT's rates are appropriately placed according to local, national, and international markets. Figure 1 below is an example that shows a gradual and consistent increase over the past 8 years for both commercial and NFP rates at the Queen Elizabeth Theatre (QET), a premiere performing arts centre that books both NFP and commercial events.





In reference to Recommendation A and B, a summary schedule of some of the key rental rates for the prior year and the proposed 2019-2020 rates (labour included unless clients have specific additional needs or requests) are shown below in figure 2 for comparison:

Staff are recommending, for all VCT rates, a 4% increase for commercial rates and a 2% increase for NFP, TRG and VCT Grant rates, across all venues (Queen Elizabeth Theatre, Orpheum, Vancouver Playhouse, Annex, QET Plaza, Ancillary Spaces) as per Appendix A and R

Both rates outlined on Appendix A and B have been reviewed and approved by the VCT Board and in preparation for a potential increase, all booking enquiries received for the 2019-2020 season have been informed of a potential rental increase pending Council approval. A letter has been sent on May 25, 2018 to regular users of VCT, informing them of the potential rental increase. If Council approves the rental rate increases, a follow-up letter will be sent to all of these organizations to confirm the increase.

Strategic Analysis

Rental rates are reviewed annually in relation to the specific economic factors, such as general inflation, cost, and labour increases, the City's budget objectives, and in relation to the local, regional and national market.

These recommended rates allow for the continuing subsidization of the Annex and the Vancouver Playhouse, where the rents are lower than their operating cost.

Facility fees

Ticketing companies charge facility fees directly to the show patrons and remit this fee to VCT. The fee, net of administrative costs (15%), is transferred to the capital facility reserve for maintenance and capital replacement of the theatres. Staff are recommending for 2019/2020 that the facility fees remain unchanged for the QET, Orpheum, Vancouver Playhouse, Annex, QET Plaza and Ancillary spaces for the following ticket prices.

\$1.00 per person for free and non-ticketed events \$2.00 per ticket sold between the value of \$0.01 and \$19.99

\$3.50 (\$3.25 Registered Non Profits) per ticket sold \$20.00 and over

Financial

The rental rate increase impacts revenues for the last four months of the 2019 fiscal year and the first 8 months of the 2020 fiscal year. The newly approved rates will be used when building the 2019 and 2020 operating budgets.

The risk associated with not implementing rate increases, as per Appendix A of 4% for commercial licensees and 2% for NFP, TRG and VCT Grant licensees, as per Appendix B, would be an impact of approximately \$177,000 (as shown in figure 3 below). This impact would be that the annual increases in labour and other operating costs would not be matched by increases in rental rate revenue, combined with the reduced ability of VCT to continue to subsidize the lower rates for the Playhouse and the Annex.

CONCLUSION

This report proposes an increase in VCT rental rates of between 2% and 4% over the 2018-2019 Rental rates. These proposed rates will effective September 1, 2019 to August 31, 2020, which will apply to all of the VCT spaces as detailed in Appendix A and Appendix B.
