





Public Input



- City-Hosted Open House: March 15, 2018
 - 20,499 notification postcards to area residents, business license holders in the area and off-site property owners
 - 160 people attended

Feedback:

- <u>Urban Design</u>: Support for new building typology; concern regarding the relationship to the residential buildings to the southwest; mixed opinion on the views lost/preserved to BC Place
- Transportation: Concern regarding perceived increased traffic stress in the area (in conjunction with the removal of the viaducts)
- Housing and Affordability: Concern for housing affordability in the development;
 general support for inclusion of both market and non-market housing in this area
- Open/Green Space: Support for active waterfront and plazas with restaurants and patios; concern for lack of green space (esp. for dogs)
- Other: Desire to see small retail units for small and local businesses; support for sustainability initiatives
