- Homeless people passing through the neighbourhood late at night with their shopping carts.
- Vancouver Indy and other major events regularly disrupts normal living at the Citygate Towers; noise and traffic especially.
- Residents state general lack of prior consultation for many of these major events, this is very frustrating, several thousands live here, more being developed.
- Motorbike racing along Quebec Street regular occurrence at night. Appears to be the same people.
