SUBJECT: Parking Requirement Standards for Multiple Residential Use

The Vancouver Bicycle Advisory Committee, at its meeting on April 20, 2005, discussed the above-noted Policy Report scheduled for consideration by the Standing Committee of Council on Transportation and Traffic on April 26, 2005, and passed the following resolution:

RESOLVED

THAT the Bicycle Advisory Committee supports the proposed reduction of parking requirements for new developments; and

FURTHER THAT the Committee recommends that for new developments the adjacent on-street parking be removed and an equivalent amount of short-term off-street parking be required to be provided within the new development, and that the resultant freed up street space be used for cycling.
