- SUBJECT: New Public Street Name: Extension of Carrall Street

RECOMMENDATION

- A. THAT the new unnamed public road located across Pacific Boulevard from the existing Carrall Street be named an extension of Carrall Street.
- B. THAT the Director of Legal Services be instructed to bring forward the appropriate amendment to the Street Name By-law.

CITY MANAGER'S COMMENTS

The City Manager RECOMMENDS approval of A and B.

COUNCIL POLICY

Council uses the Street Name By-Law, No. 4054, to name and regulate public roads in the City of Vancouver. The Street Naming Committee, a staff team, is chaired by the City Clerk, and comprised of the Archivist, City Surveyor, representatives of the Planning, Licenses & Inspections, and Fire & Rescue Services Departments. The Committee is responsible for the management of a consistent, integrated and duplication-free street name system.

PURPOSE

This report seeks Council approval for naming a new unnamed public road an extension of Carrall Street.

DISCUSSION

The Street Naming Committee was advised of an application to move existing buildings, currently addressed as 1530 and 1550 Homer Mews, to a new site, which is presently addressed as 50 Pacific Boulevard. However, based on plans submitted, the access to the buildings will be from an unnamed public road, opposite the existing Carrall Street on the other side of Pacific Boulevard (see Appendix A). The Committee agreed to name the new public road as an extension of Carrall Street.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no financial implications.

CONCLUSION

The Street Naming Committee recommends Council approve the name extension of Carrall Street for the new unnamed public road.
