SUBJECT: FCM Big City Mayors' Caucus - Sponsorship of the Welcome Reception

CONSIDERATION

COUNCIL POLICY

PURPOSE

To obtain approval from Council for the funding of the FCM Big City Mayors' Caucus Welcome Reception to be held on November 24, 2005.

BACKGROUND

The Federation of Canadian Municipalities is an association that represents the interests of every municipality and regional district in the country. The Big City Mayors' Caucus (BCMC), comprised of the mayors of Canada's 22 largest FCM member cities, meets approximately three times a year to discuss issues common to large urban areas and to bring an urban perspective to FCM's advocacy work on municipal issues. In recent years the FCM BCMC has been effective in discussions with the Federal Government resulting in new resources for all communities in Canada.

It is a long standing tradition that the host municipality sponsor the Welcome Reception. In the past, the City of Vancouver has provided funding for the BCMC welcome reception.

DISCUSSION

The FCM Big City Mayors' Caucus will be held in Vancouver on November 24 - 25, 2005.

The FCM has requested that the host city sponsor a welcome reception.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

Funding would be made available through the 2005 External Relations Operating Budget.
