SUBJECT: New Public Street Name - Extension of Hamilton Street

RECOMMENDATION

- A. THAT the new public road, directly opposite Hamilton Street across Nelson Street, be named an extension of *Hamilton Street*.
- B. THAT the Director of Legal Services be instructed to bring forward the appropriate amendments to the Street Name By-law.

CITY MANAGER'S COMMENTS

The City Manager RECOMMENDS approval of A and B.

COUNCIL POLICY

Council uses the Street Name By-Law, No. 4054, to name and regulate public roads in the City of Vancouver. The Street Naming Committee, a staff team, is chaired by the City Clerk, and comprised of the Archivist, City Surveyor, representatives of the Planning, Licenses & Inspections, and Fire & Rescue Services Departments. The Committee is responsible for the management of a consistent, integrated and duplication-free street name system.

PURPOSE

This report seeks Council approval for naming a new public road an extension of *Hamilton Street*.

DISCUSSION

At its meeting on October 5, 2006, the Street Naming Committee was advised of a new public road which will be located directly opposite the existing Hamilton Street and north of Nelson Street. The new road will be the entrance to a City parkade.

Following brief discussion, the Committee proposes naming the new road an extension of *Hamilton Street* (Appendix A).

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no financial implications.

CONCLUSION

The Street Naming Committee recommends Council approve the name extension of *Hamilton Street*.
