1. 2006 Report of the Advisory Committee on Seniors' Issues

THAT the Other Report *2006 Report of the Advisory Committee on Seniors' Issues* dated November 24, 2006, be received for information.

2. Accessibility Advisory Committee

- A. THAT staff consult with the present Advisory Committee on Seniors' Issues and the Advisory Committee on Disability Issues so that the terms of reference mandate a Committee composition for the Accessibility Advisory Committee that will fully reflect the needs of these committees in their access to city services, equal employment continuing education and other issues regarding an improved quality of life. The terms of reference for the Accessibility Advisory Committee will be brought back to Council for approval.
- B. THAT the Advisory Committee on Seniors' Issue and Advisory Committee on Disability Issues will continue to operate with its current membership until the establishment of the Accessibility Advisory Committee is completed.

3. 2121 Dundas Street - Warning to Prospective Purchasers

- A. THAT the City Clerk be directed to file a 336D Notice against the title to 2121 Dundas Street, Lot 16, Block 20, District Lot 184 Plan 178, PID 009-298-304, in order to warn prospective purchasers that eight units in the building were used as illegal marijuana grow operations and that there are contraventions of the Vancouver Building and Electrical By-laws related to these unauthorized uses.
- B. THAT implementation of A above be delayed until February 2, 2007, or to a later date as determined by staff.

4. Review of Liquor Retail Policy

- A. THAT the Liquor Store Guidelines be amended generally as shown in Appendix A of Policy Report *Review of Liquor Retail Policy*, dated December 19, 2006, to:
 - i) Provide for on-site signage about liquor store proposals, as a way to improve neighbourhood notification; and
 - ii) Recognize new Local Shopping Areas as possible locations for liquor stores.
- B. THAT the Liquor Store Guidelines be amended to allow existing small stores that sell beer and/or wine the opportunity to add spirits to their product range, by adding a new category of liquor store: a small store that sells beer, wine and/or spirits, generally as set out in Policy Report *Review of Liquor Retail Policy* dated December 19, 2006.
