SUBJECT: Chauffeur's Permit Appeal Panel - October 2008

RECOMMENDATION

THAT Council delegate the holding of a Chauffeur's Permit Appeal presently scheduled for October 2, 2008, at 7:30pm, to a panel of three Council members, pursuant to Section 277.1(1) of the Vancouver Charter, as follows:

Should any of the above Council members be unable to attend the hearing, the hearing and the power to make a Council decision in relation to this hearing be delegated to the remaining two Councillors and alternate Councillor.

COUNCIL POLICY

Section 277.1(1) of the Vancouver Charter gives Council the power to delegate the holding of a hearing under Section 275 or Section 278, or an appeal under Section 277 of this Act or under Section 36(7) of the Motor Vehicle Act, specifically, by class or generally, to one or more Council members.

PURPOSE

To establish a panel for the Chauffeur's Permit Appeal presently scheduled for October 2, 2008.

DISCUSSION

The *Vancouver Charter* confers on Council the power to delegate the holding of a hearing under Section 275 or Section 278, or an appeal under Section 277 of this Act or under Section 36(7) of the Motor Vehicle Act, specifically, by class or generally, to one or more Council members.
