 - (b) strikes out "\$40.23", and substitutes "\$41.84".

**A By-law to amend Encroachment By-law No. 4243
regarding 2009 fee increases**

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANCOUVER, in public meeting, enacts as follows:

1. From section 3A(4) of the Encroachment By-law, Council strikes out "\$42.97", and substitutes "\$44.69".

2. Council repeals Part A of the Schedule attached to the Encroachment By-law, and substitutes:

"A. PERMIT FEES, exclusive of a goods and services tax imposed under the Excise Tax Act (Canada)

For the construction, repair or removal of an encroachment:

For an encroachment of up to and including
20 square metres \$ 50.20

For each additional square metre or part
thereof \$ 4.56

To a maximum fee of..... \$352.47".

3. From Part C of the Schedule attached to the Encroachment By-law, Council strikes out "\$150.00" and "\$4.00", and substitutes "\$156.00" and "\$4.16" respectively.

4. This By-law is to come into force and take effect on January 1, 2009.

1. Council repeals Part 2 of Schedule A to the Street Distribution of Publications By-law, and substitutes:

“Part 2 - Location fee

\$26.98 annually for each of 1 to 100 news boxes held by one person

\$80.92 annually for each of 101 or more news boxes held by one person

\$107.90 annually for each compartment in each multiple publications news box

\$26.98 annually for each drop box”.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANCOUVER, in public meeting, enacts as follows:

1. This By-law amends the indicated provisions of the Street and Traffic By-law.
2. In section 23.4, Council:
 - (a) from subsection (a), strikes out "\$59.43", and substitutes "\$61.90";
 - (b) from subsection (b), strikes out "\$44.34", and substitutes "\$45.71"; and
 - (c) from subsection (c), strikes out "\$30.19", and substitutes "\$31.43".
3. From section 30(7)(c), Council strikes out "\$675.82", and substitutes "\$702.85".
4. In section 67A(6), Council:
 - (a) from subsection (a), strikes out "\$95.53", and substitutes "\$99.35"; and
 - (b) from subsection (b), strikes out "\$32.18", and substitutes "\$33.47".
5. In section 80(2), Council strikes out "\$146.84", "\$208.17", "\$635.60", "\$1,193.75", "\$2,375.44", "\$2,842.09", "\$292.66", and "\$523.97", and substitutes "\$152.71", "\$216.50", "\$661.02", "\$1,241.50", "\$2,470.46", "\$2,955.77", "\$304.37", and "\$544.93" respectively.
6. In section 96, Council strikes out "\$26.15" and "\$249.40", and substitutes "\$27.20" and "\$259.38" respectively.
7. This By-law is come into force and take effect on January 1, 2009.

4. From section 4.3.1(f), Council strikes out “116 360”, and substitutes “118 228”.

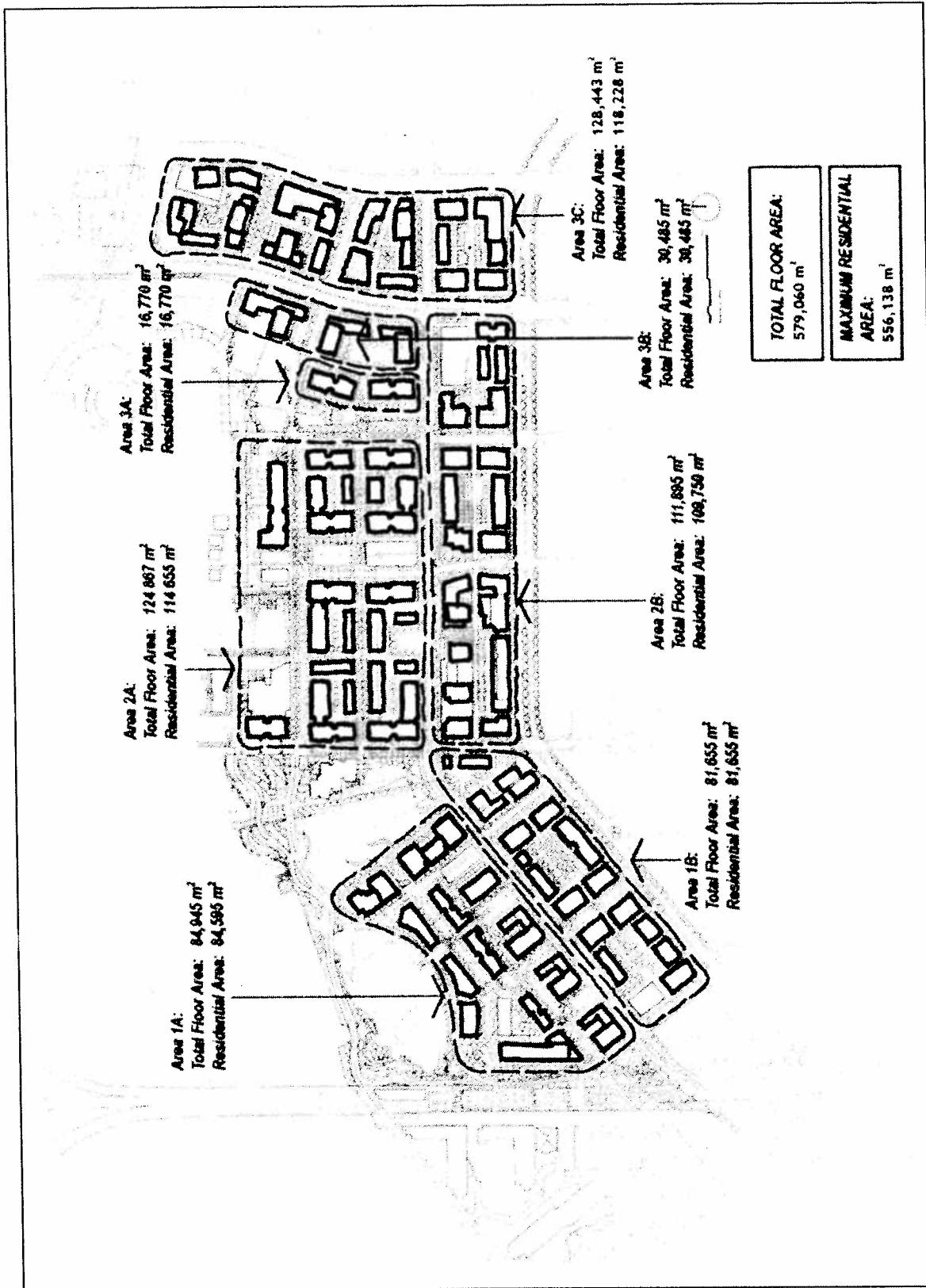


Figure 9: Maximum Heights

5. Council repeals Figures 4, 9, and 10, and substitutes:

Figure 4: Total Floor Area and Residential Floor Area

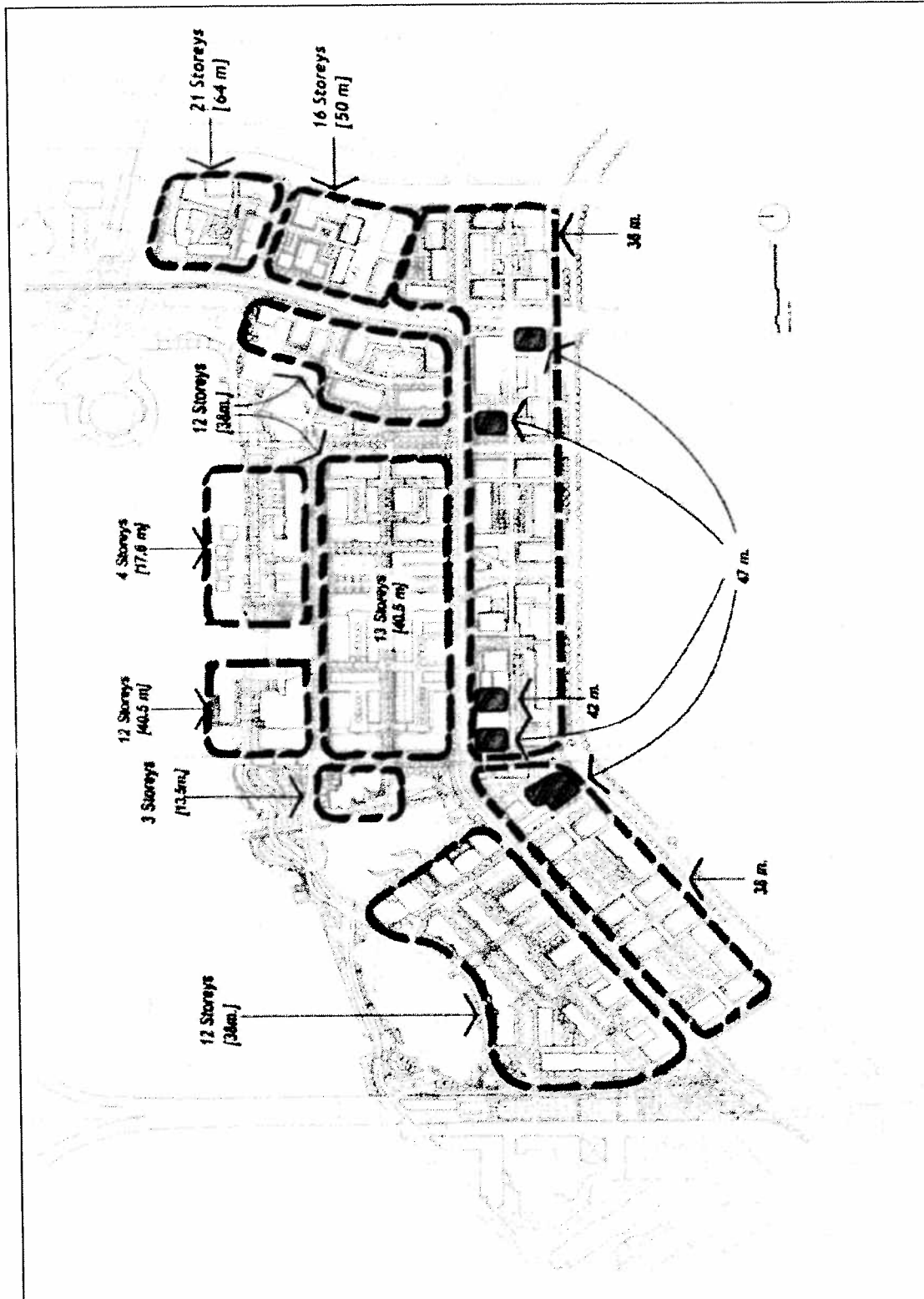
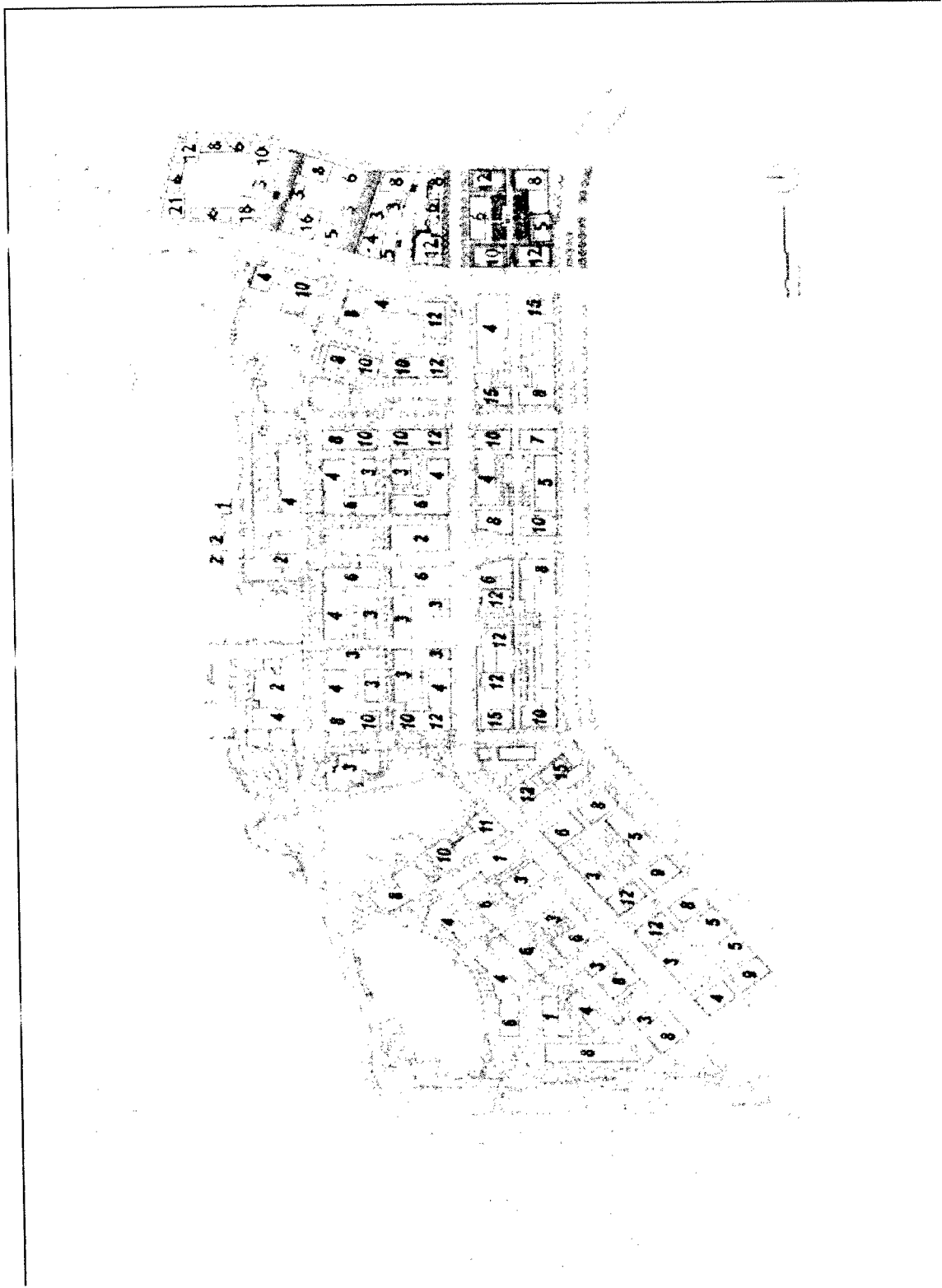


Figure 10: Optimum Heights
