The roof membrane has numerous, large blisters, has buckled in areas and has been patched a number of times. The chimneys and flashings have rusted. Much of the flashing sealants are dessicated and cracked, allowing water infiltration behind the flashings. Further delay in replacing this roof will jeopardize operation within this facility and will create a greater risk of interior damage and the potential for mould growth within the facility. A roof failure or major leak will also jeopardize the effective use of this facility in support of 2010 Olympic operations at the PNE.

A comprehensive Asbestos maintenance program is in place to comply with WorkSafeBC (WCB) regulations. However due to the age of the material and the operating requirements, it is mandated by WCB regulations to remove damaged and delaminated Asbestos Containing Material (ACM) and other hazardous materials in City owned buildings. The remaining ACM will remain in place under a maintenance program or until the facilities are demolished.

The remediation of mould from City properties is on the rise, due to the extreme weather the City has been through in the last few years. Mould is fairly easy to identify and because of this our call-outs and remediation projects have tripled in the last few years. The remediation cost of mould is extremely costly and is double the price of other hazardous materials due to the nature of the work involved. Environmental Services has been providing assistance to other departments such as Social housing, Libraries, Fire Department, Police Department, and Engineering in identifying, assessing, and removing mould and somatic materials that pose a health risk. Recently lead materials have been an issue with WorkSafeBC (WCB) in the last year on City projects. Many of the City buildings have lead-based paint or other sources of lead that will require hazard control monitoring. The old VPD firing range and Playhouse are two examples of abatement projects that were required in 2008 and require ongoing monitoring.

Work planned for 2009 for this program includes:

- FireHall (various locations) Remediation of mould/asbestos due to water-damaged roofs and structures
- C421 (Cityhall) On-going elimination of asbestos/mould in various locations identified in City Hall
- E939 (Pacific Space Centre) Asbestos Abatement required for the Greehouse Gas Reduction Project
- A872 (Manitoba Works Yard) On-going elimination of asbestos/mould in various locations identified by Environmental Services
- Various Locations Emergency Hazardous Materials abatement/remediation
- Various Locations Hazardous Materials analytical fees for mould, lead, asbestos, PCBs
- Public Safety Building Lead abatement required for former Firing Range and adjacent area, including ceiling replacement.
