SUBJECT: 2011 Engineering Fees Report

## RECOMMENDATION

A. THAT Council approve increases of 2.75% in the Engineering Services

Department permit fees totalling an estimated amount of \$87,900 as set out in Appendix A to this report, to take effect on January 1, 2011.

B. THAT the Director of Legal Services be instructed to prepare by-laws to amend the Street and Traffic by-law No. 2849, Encroachment by-law No. 4243, Crossing by-law No.4644, Street Distribution of Publications by-law No. 9350 and Street Vending by-law No. 4791, and all other license agreements referred to in Appendix A, all generally in accordance with Appendix A.

## GENERAL MANAGER'S COMMENTS

The General Manager of Engineering Services RECOMMENDS approval of the above recommendation.

# COUNCIL POLICY

Permit fees are reviewed periodically to comply with Council policy that fees recover the full cost of providing services or are equivalent to competitive charges where the fee is of a market nature.

#### **SUMMARY**

Fees are traditionally adjusted on an annual basis to keep them consistent with City costs. For 2011, the estimated increase set by the Budgets office is 2.75% and this amount has been applied to all applicable fees. Affected by-laws will be amended by Legal Services to bring forward for enactment, generally in accordance with the attached schedule in Appendix A.

## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this report is to seek Council's approval of a schedule of Engineering Permit Fees and license agreement fees which will generate an additional \$87,900 in 2011.

## **BACKGROUND**

The Engineering Services Department generates revenue from several permits, under the authority of the Street and Traffic By-Law No. 2849, Street Vending By-Law No. 4781, Crossing By-law No. 4644, Street Distribution of Publications By-law No. 9350, Encroachment By-Law No. 4243, and sidewalk patio agreements.

Fees were last adjusted in January, 2010.

## **DISCUSSION**

A list of proposed fee increases is attached to this report as Appendix A. As part of the City's 2011 budget building process, a general adjustment of 2.75% for revenues has been established. This adjustment is related to general increases in City costs to process and administer the programs associated with these fees. All of the fees in Appendix A have been increased by this amount.

Further, housekeeping changes to the Street and Traffic By-law No. 2849 is also proposed as noted below.

Subsection 26.1 of the by-law requires a person not having plainly visible permanent signage displaying the name and address of the owner or operator of a commercial vehicle to display a permit consisting of a metal plate or decal securely fastened to the front of the vehicle for which it was issued. A fee is paid for the issuance of the permit. It is proposed that an amendment to the by-law allow for a replacement fee for the metal plate or decal under subsection 21.6 of \$10.00 (plus HST). This will cover the costs of the replacement plate to the City.

## **ALTERNATIVES/OPTIONS**

Council could choose to apply a different increase than that recommended.

## FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The adjustment of 2.75% to the remainder of the fees specified in Appendix A will generate an additional amount of \$87,900.

The HST will be added to taxable fees.

## IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

Should Council approve increases to the fees identified in Appendix A, it is intended that the consequential by-law amendments will be enacted at the November 2, 2010 Council meeting to allow the implementation of the fee increases on January 1, 2011.

#### CONCLUSION

It is recommended that a 2.75% increase be to the fees specified in Appendix A. It is also recommended that Legal Services bring forward the appropriate by-law amendments for enactment.
