

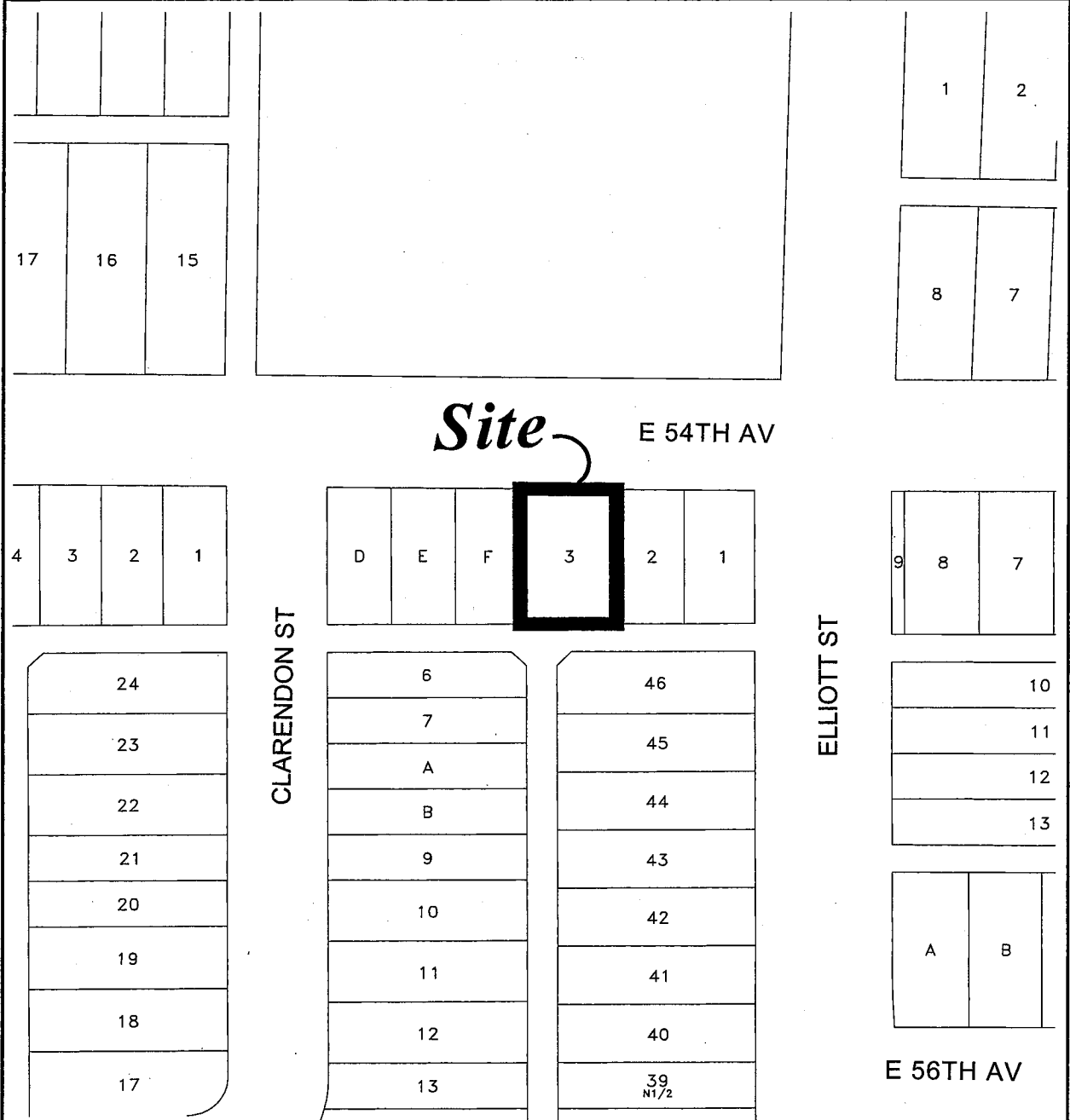



THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANCOUVER, in public meeting, enacts as follows:

1. This By-law amends the indicated provisions and schedules of the License By-law.
2. In section 2, after the definition of "Commercial Parking Lot", Council inserts:  
  
‘ “Community Association” means a society or organization incorporated and in good standing under the Society Act, or registered as a charitable society or organization under the Income Tax Act.’
3. Council repeals subsection (4) of section 19.1.
4. In section 19.2A(10) Council deletes "\$75.00" and substitutes "as set out in Part 3 of Schedule B to this By-law".
5. Council repeals section 23.1 and substitutes:  
  
"23.1 Every peddler engaged in carrying on such business or trade must carry their business licence and must produce it to the Inspector, a police officer, or a customer upon request."
6. Council:
  - (a) repeals Schedule A, and substitutes for it Schedule A attached to this By-law, which new Schedule A is to form part of the License By-law; and
  - (b) approves the fees set out in the new Schedule A.
7. Council:
  - (a) repeals Schedule B, and substitutes for it Schedule B attached to this By-law, which new Schedule B is to form part of the License By-law; and
  - (b) approves the fees set out in the new Schedule B.

1. This By-law amends the indicated provisions and schedules of the Vehicles for Hire By-law.
2. In section 6.1(3), Council strikes out subsection 6.1(3) and substitutes:

“6.1(3) Despite anything to the contrary in this By-law, the Chief Constable must refuse to issue a chauffeur’s permit to a person to drive, operate or be in charge of a taxicab unless the Chief Constable is satisfied that the applicant has successfully completed training through the TaxiHost Pro drivers course provided by the Justice Institute of British Columbia, or other similar driver training course approved by the Inspector and designed to develop the driver’s knowledge, skills, attitudes and ability to transport people with disabilities and to enhance driver safety, including assault avoidance, collision prevention and advanced geography.”
3. From section 7(6), Council strikes out “Motor Carrier Act”, and substitutes “Passenger Transportation Act”.
4. In section 20, at the end of subsection 20(k) Council deletes “and”.
5. In section 20, at the end of subsection 20(l) Council deletes “.” and substitutes “; and”.
6. In section 20, after subsection 20(l), Council adds:

“(m) the pedicab carries no more than two passengers.”
7. Council:
  - (a) repeals Schedule A, and substitutes Schedule A attached to this By-law; and
  - (b) approves the fees set out in the new Schedule A.
