Council had before it a report dated November 2, 2010, entitled "Report of the Collector of Taxes to the Local Improvement Court of Revision No. 632 - Projects by Petition". Council also had before it Appendix 1 for Project 632/007 and a Late Report for Project 632/009.

In Appendix 1 dated November 2, 2010, the Collector of Taxes advised that one property owner for Project 632/007 had submitted an additional letter of support after the petition had been certified as sufficiently signed by the Collector of Taxes, increasing the number of signatures in support of the project.

In a Late Report dated November 2, 2010, the Collector of Taxes advised that Project 632/009 does not have the required 2/3 majority support because two owners had withdrawn their support. Staff recommended the project be re-balloted.

The Collector of Taxes certified that the projects in the report dated November 2, 2010, entitled "Report of the Collector of Taxes to the Local Improvement Court of Revision No. 632 - Projects by Petition", have been requested by the majority of the assessed owners by means of a sufficiently signed petition.
