SUBJECT: 2011 Advance Cultural Grants Operating Instalments

RECOMMENDATION

A. THAT Council approve advance Cultural Grants Operating instalments in the amount of \$1,044,480 to 83 cultural organizations, in advance of their 2011 annual operating review, as listed in Appendix A.

B. THAT Council approve quarterly grant instalments in the amount of \$983,300 to the five Major Exhibiting Institutions beginning January 2011, in advance of their annual operating review, as listed in Table 1.

Source of funds for both A and B is the 2011 Cultural Grants budget.

GENERAL MANAGER'S COMMENTS

The General Manager of Community Services RECOMMENDS approval of A and B.

COUNCIL POLICY

Approval of these recommendations requires eight affirmative votes.

PURPOSE

This report recommends that Council approve advance grants and quarterly instalments in the amount of \$2,027,780 for 83 Cultural Operating Grant organizations and the five Major Exhibiting Institutions, in advance of their annual 2011 operating review.

BACKGROUND

On December 14, 1989, City Council approved the provision of advance grant instalments for Cultural Operating grants to applicants that meet specific criteria as per below. On February 1, 1996, City Council established the basis for calculating advance instalments for Cultural Grants as 40% of an applicant's Operating grant in the previous year. As amended by Council on February 5, 1998, the criteria for receipt of an advance grant are as follows:

- The applicant has received an Operating grant for at least three consecutive years.
- The applicant's Operating grant in the previous year was over \$7,500.
- An initial review of an organization's current application indicates no critical concerns about the applicant's finances, organizational sustainability or overall performance in the past year.

This policy was put into place to ease the cash flow problems that many arts organizations experience at the beginning of the calendar year. Recommendations for advance instalments are presented to Council after a preliminary staff review of grant applications. These instalments allow each organization to manage their cash flow more effectively as many funding agencies do not issue 2011 grant funds to the institutions until well into 2011.

In past years, the City has disbursed Operating grants to the five Major Exhibiting Institutions in equal instalments throughout the year. The instalments are timed to accommodate the operating cash flow requirements of these organizations.

DISCUSSION

In 2010, the City approved advance grant instalments to 77 organizations in the amount of \$978,000 and quarterly grant instalments to the five Major Exhibiting Institutions in the amount of \$985,975.

Following a preliminary staff review of the 2011 Operating Grant applications, advance instalments are recommended to 83 organizations (based on 40% of the 2010 grant) and that quarterly instalments be made to the 5 Major Exhibiting Institutions (based on 2010 funding levels).

Subject to Council approval, applicants will be notified in writing that approval of an advance grant and payment does not represent a commitment for any additional funds. The determination of additional funds depends on the grant budget levels established by Council for 2011, final Assessment Committee review of the 2011 operating grant requests, and Council's final approval of recommended allocations.

An Assessment Committee comprised of members from the arts and cultural community and Cultural Services staff will review the Operating applications. Once this process has concluded in February 2011 and Council has approved the recommendations brought forward by the Assessment Committee, the balance of grant payments will be made and adjustments (if any) will be made for the Major Exhibiting Institutions and disbursed according to the quarterly payments. Any changes to the balance of payments and the quarterly payments will accommodate for inflation or budget adjustments.

A summary of 2011 quarterly instalments for the five Majors is provided in Table 1. A summary of the 83 advance grant instalments are listed in Appendix A.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The 2011 Cultural Grants budget is \$10,554,400, pending Council approval.

This report recommends advance approval for 83 Operating grant instalments (\$1,044,480) and five quarterly instalments to Major Exhibiting Institutions (\$983,300) for a total of \$2,027,780.

Final recommendations on the 2011 Operating grants for the 83 organizations and the five Major Exhibiting Institutions will be made following a review of each organization's operational and financial performance and submitted to Council for approval in April of 2011. Pending those recommendations, any adjustments will be made to the balance of the operating grants awarded to the organizations and the instalments made to the five Major Exhibiting Institutions.

At this time, Council is requested to approve advance grant and quarterly instalments totalling \$2,027,780 as summarized in Table 2.

Vancouver's non-profit arts and cultural organizations consistently underline the value of the City's advance grant instalments in managing their cash flow needs early in the year. These instalments have also been particularly crucial in recent years given an especially challenging financial period of economic and funding uncertainty.
