The Collector of Taxes advised there is an existing curb adjacent to 5308 Angus Drive and this property should not have been included in the original petition for Project 633/004 to install pavement, curbs, trees or bulges at 37th Avenue south side from Angus Drive to Marguerite Street. This reduces the number of properties involved and the number of signatures required but the project still has sufficient signatures in support to proceed. This also affects the sharing of the cost of the project.

Appendix 2 - Request to the Court of Revision to make the following adjustment:

The Collector of Taxes advised that for Project 633/006 to install lane pavement at the lane south of 26th Avenue from lane east of Slocan Street to Kaslo Street and lane east of Slocan Street from 26th Avenue to 27th Avenue, there were two additional property owners in support and the project should proceed.

Late Report - Request to the Court of Revision to make the following adjustment:

The Collector of Taxes advised that for Project 633/010 to install speed humps at the lane south of McNicoll Avenue from Maple Street to Cypress Street, four property owners had withdrawn their support and recommended the project be re-balloted because it now does not have the required 2/3 majority support.
