Next Tuesday night will see the first of several plans by developers beginning to seek rezoning for the several blocks facing Queen Elizabeth Park- MOSAIC is the first to go with their 41 unit 5 storey project on 2 home RS-1 lots 4837-4861 cambie). BUt we have just in the past 2 weeks been to c 2 more community open houses for the blocks north and south of of this project.

Seeking rezoning soon are -1. one entire city block from West 29-West 30th - 7 homes RS-1 at s.22(1) Personal and Confidential slated for 177 units and 6 stories

high. 2. another long block of 10 homes RS-1 from West 35th to west

34(McGuigan Ave) s.22(1) Personal and Confidential slated for 161 units of 6 stories etc.

Neighbours and I are not against the need for more housing stock BUT what we see proposed so far is not at all respectful of what is a single family area which we have resided in for many years (since 1953 for me)as well as the area surrounding Q.E Park.

I phoned your office to-day and left a message asking if I could have an appointment to see you this week. Do you have anytime on Wednesday, Thursday first thing in the morning or after 3.00pm, Friday morning? I am seeking your advice/assistance to prepare to speak (as an individual resident)at city Council on Jul10th.
