SUBJECT: Vancouver Sport Hosting Grant: 2013 Spring Intake Allocations

RECOMMENDATION

THAT Council approve Sport Hosting Grants totalling \$27,500 as listed in the body of this report. Source of funds to be the 2013 Sport Hosting Grant Budget.

GENERAL MANAGER'S COMMENTS

The General Manager of the Vancouver Board of Parks and Recreation recommends approval of the foregoing.

COUNCIL POLICY

On July 13, 2006 Council approved a Sport Hosting Policy and Sport Hosting Grant Program effective January 1, 2007, with annual funding of \$200,000 to support a range of sporting events.

Approval of grant recommendations requires eight affirmative votes.

SUMMARY

This report recommends approval of Major and Community Sport Event Operating Grants totalling \$27,500.

BACKGROUND

On July 13, 2006, as part of a report on the development of a comprehensive Vancouver Sport Strategy, Council approved a Sport Hosting Grant Program with annual funding of \$200,000 to support a range of sporting events.

Specific assessment guidelines were also outlined in the Council report and three types of grants were designed to support sport hosting:

Major Sport Event Operating Grant - Funding for direct operating costs not to exceed the lesser of 30% of the event's total gross operating budget or \$100,000.

Major Sport Event City Service Offset Grant - Funding to offset direct city services such as police, engineering, parks, not to exceed the lesser of 50% of an event's city service costs or \$10,000.

Community Sport Event Operating Grant - Funding for direct operating costs not to exceed the lesser of 30% of an event's total gross operating budget or \$5,000.

Note:

\$199,747 has been returned back to the program as some events were cancelled or did not meet spending thresholds.

The approved grant amount includes funding commitments beyond 2013 for 2015 FIFA Women's Cup.

DISCUSSION

All Sport Hosting grant applications are reviewed by a panel comprised of representatives from the Park Board and other key stakeholders in the sport hosting community.

The panel received eleven applications during the spring 2013 intake. There were six applications for major operating grants and five for community grants. The panel met to review applications on May 2, 2013.

Summary of Review Panel Recommendations

The Review Panel applied the criteria outlined in the assessment guidelines carefully. Not all organizations or events met the required criteria and therefore some applications could not be recommended for support.

The table below outlines the organizations which applied for grants, the amounts requested, and the recommendations of the review panel.

(1): This figure includes \$125,000 contribution to FIFA, \$100,000 to Davis Cup and a total of \$74,750 in smaller grants contributions to various organizations.

As noted above, \$55,852 is currently available for funding the 2013 spring applications. With consideration for funding commitments already made, this will leave \$28,352 remaining for the fall 2013 grant intake based on approval of the current recommendation. The next intake closes on the last day of October, and a report recommending allocation from the fall intake will be presented to the Council before the end of the year.

It should be noted that there is a commitment of \$125,000 of the \$250,000 in funding approved by Council on February 3, 2011 (RTS 9059) for hosting the 2015 FIFA Women's World Cup. The additional \$125,000 will be funded from the 2014 and 2015 Vancouver Sport Hosting Grant budget.

CONCLUSION

The Sport Hosting Grant review panel recommends support for grants totaling \$27,500 as outlined in the body of this report. The recommendations reflect a careful and considered process within the policy and guidelines provided by Council.
