Issues of concern for the City of Vancouver related to the placement of the new community mail boxes may include but not be limited to: access for Seniors and Persons with Disabilities, the location of the boxes, traffic, parking, land use policy, street lighting, littering, snow and ice clearance, theft and vandalism.

- A. THAT staff report back to Council on the potential implications of the loss of Canada Post delivery to the citizens of Vancouver, especially Seniors and Persons with Disabilities.
- B. THAT staff report back to Council on what form of consultation process the City of Vancouver can expect with Canada Post.
- C. THAT staff report back to Council on potential options to mitigate the impacts of this new Canada Post policy, in order to ensure the most positive outcome possible for the residents of Vancouver.
