BY-LAW NO. _____

A By-law to designate certain real property as protected heritage property

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANCOUVER, in public meeting, enacts as follows:

1. Council considers that portions of the existing facades of the real property described as:

The south and east facades, approximately four and feet of the west facade and approximately fifteen feet of the north façade, and including the existing entrance lamp pillars and wrought iron balconies on the east façade, generally as depicted in the diagrams attached hereto as Schedule A

have heritage value or heritage character, and that designation of those portions of the existing facades as protected heritage property is necessary or desirable for their conservation.

2. Council designates the real property described in section 1 of this By-law as protected heritage property under Section 593 of the *Vancouver Charter*.

3. The Schedule attached to this By-law forms part of this By-law.


4. This By-law is to come into force and take effect on the date of its enactment.


