MOTION ON NOTICE

2. Allowing for the Sale of Craft Made Spirits, Beer and Wine at Farmers Markets

WHEREAS:

1. The City of Vancouver has established a robust, vibrant network of Farmers Markets throughout the City;
2. The City of Vancouver fully supports the development of the local Craft Made Spirits, Beer and Wine industries;
3. The Province of British Columbia has recently enacted new policies which allow for the sale of craft made spirits, beer and wine at Farmers' Markets throughout British Columbia;
4. Although the City of Vancouver has not yet updated its guidelines to allow for the sale of such products at Farmers Markets throughout the city, staff have made it publicly known that a pilot program is being put in place for this summer in advance of any by-law changes.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED

- A. THAT Council approve the pilot program to allow for the sale of craft made spirits, beer and wine at Farmers' Markets as was made public on Friday, June 27, 2014.
- B. THAT following completion of the pilot program, staff will, as a priority, revise the City's guidelines for the sale of Craft Made Spirits, Beer and Wine at Farmers Markets in order that such sales will be allowed to take place.
