At the Regular Council meeting on October 28, 2014, Councillor Louie submitted the following motion. Councillor Affleck called notice under section 10.3(d) of the *Procedure By-law*.

1. Recognizing Lilian To

WHEREAS

1. It has been nearly 10 years since the passing of Lilian To, former Chief Executive Officer of S.U.C.C.E.S.S., who has left behind a substantial legacy and achievements in making Vancouver a more inclusive city, free of racism, and creating mutual understanding and respect for all residents of Vancouver;
2. Lilian To's achievements and advocacy for settlement, health, family, seniors, and youth services for newcomers reinforce the City of Vancouver's values and policies to provide accessible and culturally responsive services to the diverse population in Vancouver.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED

- A. THAT Council direct staff to report back on the options to identify an appropriate place or civic asset or street, preferably in the Chinatown area or close to S.U.C.C.E.S.S.'s office, to be named in recognition of Lilian To and her lifetime achievements advocating for the rights, responsibilities and benefits of newcomers to the City of Vancouver.
- B. THAT Council direct staff to report back on the options available to commemorate the legacy and achievements of Lilian To by the next Council meeting.
