SUBJECT: 2015 Engineering Fees

# RECOMMENDATION

- A. THAT Council approve increases of 2% in the Engineering Services Department permit fees as set out in Appendix A to this report, with the exception of the fees referenced in Recommendation B, to take effect on January 1, 2015.
- B. THAT Council increase the Street Utilities By-law Fees: Plan review and administration fee (alignment that is less than 20 metres), Plan review and administration fee (alignment that is greater than 20 metres), Additional per metre fee for the proposed alignment, Inspection fee per street block per day, and Pavement degradation costs by 1.3% to be consistent with Municipal Access Agreements.
- C. THAT the Director of Legal Services be instructed to prepare by-laws to amend the Street and Traffic By-law No. 2849, Encroachment By-law No. 4243, Crossing By-law No. 4644, Street Distribution of Publications By-law No. 9350, Street Utilities By-law No. 10361 and Street Vending By-law 10868, all generally in accordance with Appendix A.

## REPORT SUMMARY

Fees are traditionally adjusted on an annual basis to reflect cost increases. For 2015 the proposed increase is 2% with the exception of Street Utilities By-law Fees, which is to be increased by 1.3%. The rationale for these fee increases are described in this report.

#### COUNCIL AUTHORITY/PREVIOUS DECISIONS

Permit fees are reviewed as part of the annual budget process to comply with Council policy that fees recover the full cost of providing services or are equivalent to competitive charges where the fee is of a market nature.

## CITY MANAGER'S/GENERAL MANAGER'S COMMENTS

The General Manager of Engineering Services RECOMMENDS approval of the above recommendations.

## REPORT

#### Background/Context

The Engineering Services Department generates revenues from several permits, under the authority of the Street and Traffic By-law No. 2849, Street Vending By-law No.10868, Crossing By-law No. 4644, Street Distribution of Publications By-law No. 9350, Encroachment By-law No. 4243, Street Utilities By-law No. 10631 and sidewalk patio agreements.

Fees were last adjusted in January 2014.

#### Strategic Analysis

Fees are set at a level which reflects the City's costs structure and are generally inflated annually. The recommendation for the fee increase considers the current inflation rate (based on the 12-month average percentage change in Vancouver Consumer Price Index), prior year inflation, and forecasts for the following year. Prior year fee increases were 2.75% for 2011, 2% for 2012 and 2013, and 1% for 2014.

The Vancouver Consumer Price Index (CPI) is forecasted to increase 1.5% for the year 2014 and 2.1% for 2015. Considering these forecasts and historic trends, a 2% fee increase is recommended for 2015. This is consistent with the permit, license and service fee increases approved by Council in September 2013.

This 2% increase has been applied to all of the fees listed in Appendix A with the exception of the fees noted below.

#### Street Utilities By-law Fees

Work done with telecommunication companies to install infrastructure in City streets is governed by the Street Utilities By-law and Municipal Access Agreements (MAA) which were formed by Canadian Radio-television Telecommunications Commission (CRTC) ruling. This agreement indicates the fees and charges to be used and that these fees and charges be adjusted annually on December 31<sup>st</sup> in accordance with the Consumer Price Index (CPI) as published by Statistics Canada. The Street Utilities By-law will need to be adjusted to reflect adjusted rates for 2015 based on the Statistics

Canada published CPI increase of 1.3% from September 2013 to September 2014. The specific fees that are recommended to be increased by this rate are:

- A. Plan review and administration fee (alignment that is less than 20 metres)
- B. Plan review and administration fee (alignment that is greater than 20 metres)
- C. Additional per metre fee for the proposed alignment
- D. Inspection fee per street block per day
- E. Pavement degradation costs

## Implications/Related Issues/Risk (if applicable)

#### Financial

The adjustment to the fees specified in Appendix A is expected to generate an additional amount of revenue in 2015 of approximately \$110,000.

GST, as applicable, will be added to taxable fees.

## Legal

Legal Services will update the relevant by-laws to reflect the change in fees.

## CONCLUSION

It is recommended that the fee increases indicated in Appendix A of this report be applied to be effective January 1, 2015. It is also recommended that Legal Services bring forward the appropriate by-law amendments for consideration by Council.
