I would like to voice my concern over the proposed rezoning on west 6th Avenue.

My concern falls into two categories.

First and foremost, my concern is the Height if the proposed structure. I am a resident of s. 22(1) Personal and Confidential and my suite is on the s. 22(1) Personal and Confidential which has a tremendous view of water, mountain, and Stanley Park. I believe the view of Stanley Park will be gone from my residence if 12 stories go up at the proposed site.
