Dear city council,

I am writing to share my opposition to the proposed by-law amendment. While I would gladly accept the opportunity to share my thoughts at the coming public meeting, I will likely not be able to attend as it starts when I finish work.

My rationale is as follows:

- 1) the city should be retaining zoning for business, as these business add jobs that sustain our economy.
- 2) a 12 story tower is significantly taller than other buildings on the west side of fir, and will negatively alter the skyline for many residents in the area.
- 3) There is already one low income rental building in the area, and it's not fair to the residents who have purchased real-estate in the vicinity to have the composition and value of their neighborhood further negatively affected.
