MATTERS ADOPTED ON CONSENT

MOVED by Councillor Deal

THAT items 3 and 4 be adopted on consent.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

1. Recognizing Pat Quinn's Contributions to Vancouver February 4, 2015

Planning and Development Services staff presented the report and responded to questions.

MOVED by Mayor Robertson THAT the Committee recommend to Council

A. THAT the existing segment of Abbott Street, between Expo Boulevard and Pacific Boulevard, directly east of Rogers Arena, as shown on the map attached as Appendix A to the Administrative Report dated February 4, 2015,

- entitled "Recognizing Pat Quinn's Contributions to Vancouver", be renamed "Pat Quinn Way", in recognition of Pat Quinn's contributions to Vancouver.
- B. THAT the Director of Legal Services be instructed to bring forward the appropriate amendment to the Street Name By-law.
- C. THAT the General Manager of Engineering Services be directed to expedite fabrication and installation of revised street signage.

2. Approval of Commercial Drive BIA Renewal and Hastings North BIA Expansion February 19, 2015

Planning and Development Services staff reviewed the report and responded to questions.

The Committee heard from the Executive Directors of the Commercial Drive and Hastings North BIAs, both of whom spoke in support of the report and responded to questions.

MOVED by Councillor Deal
THAT the Committee recommend to Council

- A. THAT Council approve the application of the Commercial Drive Business Society (CDBS), as described in the Administrative Report dated February 19, 2015, entitled "Approval of Commercial Drive BIA Renewal and Hastings North BIA Expansion";
 - FURTHER THAT Council instruct the Director of Legal Services, in consultation with the Director of Planning, to bring forward by-laws to re-establish the Commercial Drive BIA, to establish a new funding ceiling, and to remit monies for the business promotion scheme.
- B. THAT Council approve the application of the Hastings North Business Improvement Association (HNBIA), as described in the Administrative Report dated February 19, 2015, entitled "Approval of Commercial Drive BIA Renewal and Hastings North BIA Expansion";
 - FURTHER THAT Council instruct the Director of Legal Services, in consultation with the Director of Planning, to bring forward by-laws to expand the Hastings North BIA, establish a funding ceiling, and to remit monies for the business promotion scheme.

3. Reallocation of Phase II Grant for Historic Green House at 1885 Venables Street at Vancouver East Cultural Centre February 18, 2015

THAT the Committee recommend to Council

- A. THAT Council approve the reallocation of \$902,500 remaining funding from the Vancouver East Cultural Centre (VECC) Phase 2 Grant Budget to a new Capital project for renovating and upgrading the City owned and VECC operated "Green House" at 1885 Venables Street. This project is to be managed by Real Estate & Facilities Management subject to approval by the Managing Director of Cultural Services.
- B. THAT Council approve the reallocation of \$50,000 from the Environmental Hazardous Materials Program to fund the additional remediation cost for the Green House Project. The total project budget is \$952,500.

ADOPTED ON CONSENT AND BY THE REQUIRED MAJORITY

4. Contract Award for Supply and Delivery of Heavy Duty Fire Apparatus January 16, 2015

THAT the Committee recommend to Council

- A. THAT Council authorize City staff to negotiate to the satisfaction of the General Manager of Vancouver Fire and Rescue Services (VF&RS), Director of Legal Services and the Chief Purchasing Official and enter into a contract with Safetek Emergency Vehicles Ltd. for the supply and delivery of 25 heavy duty fire apparatus at an estimated value of \$33,235,238, which includes PST, subject to the approval of B below.
- B. THAT Council approve an increase to the Multi-Year Capital Project Budget for replacement of Fire Apparatus and Vehicles in the amount of \$10,365,238, for a total revised Multi-Year Capital Project Budget of \$35,235,238 of which this award forms a portion (\$33,235,238), with no overall increase in the 2015-2018 Capital Plan as outlined in the financial implications section of the Administrative Report dated January 16, 2015, entitled "Contract Award for Supply and Delivery of Heavy Duty Fire Apparatus".

The funding sources for the increased Multi-Year Capital Project Budget for Fire Apparatus and Vehicles will be:

- Plant and Equipment Reserve \$8,703,819
- UEL Fire Truck Replacement Reserve \$1,661,419

- C. THAT the Director of Legal Services be authorized to execute on behalf of the City the contract contemplated by A above.
- D. THAT no legal rights or obligations will be created by Council's adoption of A and B above unless and until such contract is executed by the Director of Legal Services.
