Please support re-zoning 508 Helmcken to allow construction of a 36-storey building by Brenhill Developments Ltd. with condos and 110 rental units, which in turn will provide the benefit of new low-income housing at the New Jubilee House directly across the street from 508 Helmcken.

I applaud the City for partnering with the private sector to create social housing, as in requiring Brenhill Developments to pay up front for the construction of New Jubilee House as their Community Amenity Contribution.
