According to information we received, a rezoning sign was installed on the site on May 21, two days after our article was posted, and **just five days** before the public hearing.

We also encourage this Public Hearing to discuss and reconfirm the City's requirements for proponents to provide proper notice of a rezoning and public hearing.

The fact that this project in particular is being processed as a Rental 100 project with rezoning and development application being handled concurrently and therefore this being the only real chance for the public to address City officials about this development -- a significant new precedent in the community -- is another good reason to remove it from this agenda for May 26 and set a new date.
