SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS



THAT Council approve, in principle, the conceptual design for the Davie Village Public Space Improvements, including a permanent plaza on Bute Street south of Davie to the lane, to be named "Jim Deva Plaza";

THAT staff be directed to report back to Council by December 2015 with the detailed design, funding strategy, plaza management strategy, and a preliminary concept for an LGBTQ "outdoor museum";

THAT Council approve additional funds from an existing CAC to advance development of the "outdoor museum" and the plaza management strategy.



Support for improvements:


Permanent plaza: 72%




RECOGNITION OF LGBTQ COMMUNITY



Concept: Jim Deva's commemoration as part of a broader LGBTQ "outdoor museum"

Museum focused in the plaza, potentially with elements throughout Davie Village

PLAZA MANAGEMENT STRATEGY



Required to guide the use & programming of the plaza

Help ensure it is a safe, comfortable & inclusive gathering space

Key considerations:

- 2. Programming

Public safety:

Regulation/enforcement

Programming:

Access to supportive infrastructure

Scheduling & permitting

Moveable furniture

Expanded patios

Prepare detailed design, funding strategy & implementation plan

Additional consultation re: commemorative & LGBTQ outdoor museum components

Prepare plaza management strategy, including appropriate amendments to Street & Traffic By-law
