As a resident living two blocks away, I object to the plan of the Jericho Tennis Club to reduce its required number of parking spaces. This neighbourhood is already inundated with an excess of cars parked on our streets. Cars are frequently illegally parked in resident only spaces and too close to street corners. Reducing the number of parking spaces will only aggravate a bad situation.

The tennis club already has over ten bicycle parking spots in front of the courts on Point Grey Rd. There is ample room to introduce more bicycle racks there and if necessary the planted area can be slightly reduced to accommodate them.
