RE: 798 Granville Street - Electronic Video Sign - Sign By-law Amendment

The Downtown Vancouver Business Improvement Association (DVBIA) supports proposed amendments to the Sign By-law to allow two 9.2 m x 6.1 m (56 m2) electronic video signs located at 798 Granville Street. The signs will contribute the bright and cosmopolitan style of the intersection, in addition to providing space for advertising, community announcements, and public art.

The video signs will be angled toward pedestrians at the street level and will not exceed brightness standards.

The DVBIA encourages neon and video signage in the Granville Entertainment District. Granville Street was at one time second to Las Vegas as the neon capital of North America. Bright signage is an important part of the heritage and identity of Granville Street and we recommend that this legacy be protected and enhanced.
