SUBJECT: Miscellaneous Amendments: 155 East 37th Avenue (Little Mountain)

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This memorandum informs Council that one of the items contained in the Policy Report dated June 5, 2018, titled "Miscellaneous Amendments - Zoning and Development By-law, Various CD-1 By-laws, and Noise Control, Parking and Sign By-laws", which was referred on June 19, has been removed.

The item that was removed was for 155 East 37th Avenue (Little Mountain), and required that its CD-1 By-law be enacted before the miscellaneous amendments were scheduled for public hearing. That CD-1 By-law enactment has not yet been considered by Council. As a result, the amendment related to that CD-1 will be rescheduled for another public hearing once the CD-1 has been enacted.

Accordingly, 155 East 37th Avenue (Little Mountain) is not included in the Summary and Recommendation that staff have prepared for the Miscellaneous Amendments report, nor has the draft by-law amending the CD-1 been posted. No action by Council is required.
