# 2. Submit a video of your comments to Mayor and Council

- State your position (i.e. in support or opposed) in the video.
- The deadline to send your video is 15 minutes after the speaker's list closes.
- If you send your video during the meeting, use a maximum of 1,500 words.
- Video comments are posted on our website.
- Submit a video with your comments by:
  - USB to the City Clerk's Office, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, Vancouver City Hall
  - Posting to an online platform such as YouTube and sending the video link to <u>publichearing@vancouver.ca</u>

- 3. Attend the Public Hearing in person and speak to Mayor and Council
