- SUBJECT: Street Naming Naming of Street Extensions Adjacent to Little Mountain Development

#### RECOMMENDATION

- A. THAT the new public street between Quebec and Ontario Streets, running south from East 33<sup>rd</sup> Avenue to the extension of East 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue noted in C below, be named "James Street" as it is an extension of the existing street.
- B. THAT the new public street between Ontario and Main Streets, running north from East 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue to the extension of East 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue noted in C below, be named "Quebec Street" as it is an extension of the existing street.
- C. THAT the new public street between East 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue and East 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue, running west from Main Street to the extension of Quebec as noted in B above, be named "East 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue" as it is an extension of the existing street.
- D. THAT the new public street between East 33<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and the extension of East 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue as noted in C above, running west from Quebec Street to the extension of James Street as noted in A above, be named "East 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue" as it is an extension of the existing street.
- E. THAT the Director of Legal Services be instructed to bring forward for enactment the appropriate amendments to the Street Name By-law.

All of the above street extensions are as shown in the graphic attached as Appendix A.

### **CITY MANAGER'S COMMENTS**

The City Manager submits the foregoing for consideration.

#### **COUNCIL POLICY**

Council uses the Street Name By-Law, No. 4054, to name and regulate public roads in the City of Vancouver. The Civic Asset Naming Committee was established by Council on February 29, 2012, and re-established on December 16, 2014. The Committee approves names to be added to the Names Reserve List based on input from staff regarding compliance with naming policies and guidelines and also recommends names to Council for new streets and roads, development areas, pedestrian and cycling infrastructure, and other City-owned assets and facilities (excluding Parks and Library assets).

#### PURPOSE

This report seeks Council approval of naming new public streets adjacent to the Little Mountain redevelopment as extensions of existing street names.

#### BACKGROUND

On December 7, 2015, the Civic Asset Naming Committee considered several public streets to be created adjacent to the Little Mountain development. As all of the streets represented extensions to existing streets already named, it was agreed that the streets would be named accordingly, in compliance with City naming policies and guidelines which call for a continuous street name system.

All of the new streets have now been established by way of registration of a Statutory Right of Way in favour of the City for street purposes.

#### FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no financial implications.

#### CONCLUSION

The Civic Asset Naming Committee recommends Council approve the names "East 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue", "East 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue", "Quebec Street" and "James Street", as they represent extensions of existing streets.
