

SPECIAL COUNCIL COURT OF REVISION – LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS MEETING MINUTES

NOVEMBER 22, 2018

A Special Meeting of the Council of the City of Vancouver was held on Thursday, November 22, 2018, at 5:01 pm, in the Council Chamber, Third Floor, City Hall, for the purpose of holding a Court of Revision pertaining to local improvement projects.
