To the Mayor and City Council,

My name is Pavan and I am single mother with 2 young children. And like any other single mother with children, we know what struggle means. I am not here to tell my story but I am here to write to you about my everyday struggle of finding an affordable and secure rental place I can call home. I have moved home to home in Vancouver for many reasons. I.e. Rent increase, renovation of the unit, mold in the living space getting my children sick. Even right now, I am worried because I don't know when my current landlord will decide to increase the rent or just want me to move out. It's a constant subconscious stress. My kids have changed schools 4 times. I wonder if you all have kids, and just think about the impact that may have on your children. It saddens me when my kids have to say goodbye to their friends. I can't drive them to the same school because I don't have a car and rely on public transportation.

I have looked at new clean housing (without asbestos and mould) in the Sunrise Hastings area for a long time; this location is ideal because it takes me to Downtown in minimal time and the rent is way cheaper than downtown. From Renfrew, I would only need to take one bus to get to downtown. The bus stop is right outside the door. I don't want to be on East Hastings because it is too busy of a main road to be with children. When I found out about this affordable rental

building I got really excited. I am sending this letter to you in support of the building. Like many single parents, I need to be with our kids in the evenings and therefore, I won't be able to come to the open hearing on June 11. I would like to move into this building because of the bike path for my kids and the public transport right outside the door. It is a great neighborhood to raise a family. It is perfect.

I really hope the city builds many rental housing units such as this one because then the landlord has minimal incentive to evict the tenants. The housing is more secured for the tenant. And I have been looking for a long time, and securing a home in this community would be a dream come true my me and my 2 daughters.
