RE: rezoning application for 708 to 796 Renfrew

I have an interest in 880 Renfrew and am interested in redeveloping the site.

I strongly support this rezoning and Development Permit application. I believe the City should do everything to accelerate the completion of this project.

I would like to express my view that this process has been unduly delayed to date. This project should have been under construction this year but was delayed because certain area residents objected to what was a very well-designed project and the project was forced to redesign.

In my view it was a real shame to observe the delay in process that has resulted in a loss of rental housing opportunities in a location that is entirely appropriate for redevelopment. The reduction in GFA and units was a real loss of tangible benefit to the 50% of residents in Vancouver who rent.
