This note is in support of the proposed development at 4575 Granville Street.

Building diverse housing options is a top priority for Vancouver and the greater region, and this proposal offers homes that fulfill many criteria currently underserved and unmet in the current housing market. It is family-friendly, secured rental, in townhouse forms, has ample outdoor space, and is along a key transit corridor connected to both South Vancouver and Downtown.
