This email is about 4575 Granville Street, which I support. I'm a concerned citizen.

The Shaughnessy area has been a blight on this city since its inception. Suburban sprawl contributing to the fossil fuel crisis, resource and water-sucking lawns, a street pattern that destroys the city's grid, and hostility to all types of transit and development improvements. The area represents a Victorian landowner's ideal that is an albatross around the neck of the modern city, and we all suffer for its existence.

4575 Granville Street represents a break from an obsolete mode of living. It is an attractive, dense and convenient project that should be built and replicated both in Shaughnessy and elsewhere. I support it for a number of reasons including the following:
