Hi,

This is a terrible idea for three reasons:

- 1) There is already a distillery (even if it only flavours its booze, rather than distill it from scratch) at Hornby and Beach. One is enough for a two block radius.
- 2) There is already a full service liquor store within three blocks. We do not need another liquor outlet selling spirits on Granville.
- 3) The commercial area linked to Vancouver House promised to be a market with businesses catering to local residents (a "Granville Market North" might have been the term used). Taking up such a large area at ground level means that useful businesses (green grocer, butcher, fishmonger, deli, etc.) will be squeezed out by an unnecessary, unhealthy one.

We oppose this proposition strongly.
