

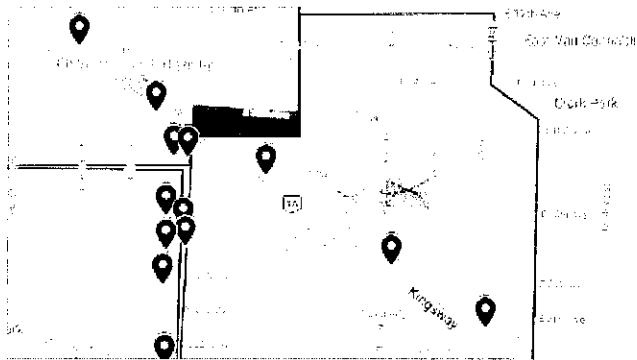

Fraser Street Neighbourhood Committee started this petition to Vancouver City Council and 11 others

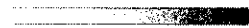
The Fraser Street community is a model of socio-economic and cultural diversity, with a long history of residential neighbourhoods and independent small businesses.
